

Sully 2023 Non-Model A Judging Guidelines

Notify the Chief Judge if you find any car leaking gasoline, or observe any other unsafe situation!

Be at judging tent at 10:00 a.m. Return all forms by 12:30 p.m.

Award points up to the maximum in the judged area; 55 points needed to place. Car must have “in the green” Fire Extinguisher to be judged. **NO PARTIAL POINTS – WHOLE NUMBERS ONLY – ABSOLUTELY NO TIES!** See section 4 below.

Appearance judging = “No Rust, No Dust, No Bust”.

Specific Guidelines

1. Interior – Up to 25 points:

- a. Upholstery and hardware – Consider: For upholstery the material should be clean and free of rips or tears. Seat belts (if present) should appear to be clean and functional (e.g., not frayed or torn/cut). Interior hardware should be clean with plating intact. For interior metal parts consider condition of paint, plating and cleanliness.
- b. Carpet, floor mats, garnish molding, and windows – Consider: general condition, degree of wear, brightness of colors and cleanliness. Windows may be up or down; visible glass must be clean and intact.
- c. Instrument panel, pedals, steering column & controls – Consider: general condition, degree of wear, brightness of colors, and cleanliness.
- d. Trunk (should be open) – Consider: general condition, degree of wear, brightness of colors and cleanliness. Withhold 5 points if trunk is closed.

2. Exterior – Up to 50 points:

- a. Paint, lights, top – Consider: cleanliness and the condition as compared to when new. Apply same standard to convertible tops or removable tops. Allow for road dust from the drive in; deduct for excessive dirt, excess grease, and oil leaks.
- b. Wheels and Tires – Consider: cleanliness and the condition as compared to when new.

3. Mechanical – Up to 25 Points:

- a. Engine compartment (Hood must be open) – Consider: Paint job and cleanliness of block; neatness and cleanliness of the engine compartment; Condition of wiring and other painted parts, rubber and plastic. Deduct 15 points if engine compartment is closed.
- b. Suspension and underbody – Consider: cleanliness and the condition of the parts, such as excessive dirt and grease, damage or major rust. Undercoating in good condition is acceptable.
- c. Exhaust system. Consider: excessive rust and general condition. Stainless systems are acceptable. Note: Surface rust is acceptable on non-stainless systems.

4. Other Considerations – Up to 5 Points:

What is the history of this car? Consider originality. Written documentation is best if available and realistic. Or, if written documentation is not available describe your rationale for awarding Extra Points. You may use either approach or a combination of the two for awarding up to five (5) points **ONLY** to break ties.
