Sully 2023 Special Displays Judging Guidelines

Notify the Chief Judge if you find any vehicle leaking gasoline, or if you observe any other unsafe situation!

- 1. Be at judging tent at 10:00 a.m. return all forms by 12:30 p.m.
- 2. Award points up to the maximum in the judged area; 55 points needed to place. **NO PARTIAL POINTS WHOLE NUMBERS NO TIES!** See section 5 below.

Special Display Judging Requirements

Specific Guidelines

1. Safety – 0 Points

- a. If safety requirements are not met, the entry will not be judged. A "Fire Extinguisher" is required and must be "in the green" if a combustion engine is part of the display.
- b. Supervision of the display is in place. For this item is it apparent that supervision is present. See item 2. c.
- c. Is the Audience at a safe distance away from the display.

2. Presentation – Up to 25 Points

- a. The display is organized and understandable.
- b. The display is well-explained.
- c. The display area is supervised and well managed.

3. Exterior Appearance – Up to 25 Points

- a. Evaluate the general appearance of the display. Inspect the metal/material for damage, paint condition and as applicable tires. The display should be reasonably clean and in good appearance.
- b. Allow for road dust from the drive in.

4. Mechanical – Up to 25 Points

- a. The machinery is in good running order.
- b. Look for excessive knocking or grinding as applicable.
- c. The machinery is clean and neat.
- 5. Significance to Sully Car show and to History Up to 25 Points: Note This section is used to break ties regardless of the type of display. Because some displays may lend themselves to more or less evaluation points the following areas should be seriously considered.
- a. The significance to the Sully Car show should be considered in your evaluation. The display has an interesting history.
- b. Consider the display in terms of uniqueness and rarity. Is it a one-of-a-kind?
- c. Consider the historical status Social position in history; the enjoyment of individuals attending the show; the entertainment the display provides to attendees; or increase efficiencies in the work place. Does the display help make tough jobs easier to perform?
