- Show field is limited to 400 cars.
- Flea Market registration gate closes at 8:30 a.m.
- First 400 cars registered will receive a plaque.
- Registration open to Antique, Classic and Special Interest cars only. Due to space limitations the registrar reserves the right to refuse entrance to any vehicle not preserved in the interest of the hobby. **Sorry, no modifieds, repli-cars, or partial restorations.**
- **Cutoff date for pre-registered vehicles is June 14, 2006.**
- Fee: Pre-registered \$10.00; at the gate \$15.00.
- Car Corral: Pre-registered \$30.00; at the gate \$45.00 Flea Market Spaces: Pre-registered \$30, at gate \$45
- Trophies awarded at 3:30 p.m. Winners are responsible for picking up their own trophies. No trophies will be mailed.
- Due to limited space **NO** vehicle later than **1972** will be admitted.
- All cars through 1920 will be admitted free.
- Cars displaying FOR SALE signs will be charged Car Corral fee.

Show field limited to 400 cars. **Pre-registered cars will be parked by class . Others will be parked in designated parking areas.**
